#### Child-Safe Policy

#### Objective:

St George Dance Eisteddfod is committed to providing a safe and secure environment for all participants, with a special focus on the well-being of children involved in our event. This Child-Safe Policy outlines our dedication to safeguarding children from harm and promoting their overall welfare during all aspects of the Eisteddfod.

#### **Guidelines:**

#### Participant Welfare:

- All participants, including children, have the right to participate in a safe and respectful environment.
- Ensure appropriate supervision by designated responsible adults during rehearsals, performances, and any related activities.

#### Communication:

- Maintain transparent and open communication channels with parents, guardians, and participants regarding schedules, expectations, and any concerns.
- Provide a clear point of contact for reporting any issues or seeking assistance related to child safety.

#### Staff and Volunteer Screening:

• Screen all staff, adjudicators, and volunteers involved in the Eisteddfod to ensure they meet appropriate standards and hold valid Working With Children Checks, Police Checks or equivalent.

#### Code of Conduct:

• Implement and communicate a Code of Conduct that emphasizes respectful and appropriate behaviour towards children and ensures a safe and positive atmosphere.

#### Physical Safety:

- Ensure all venues and facilities adhere to safety standards, with particular attention to age-appropriate facilities for children.
- Implement measures to prevent and respond to accidents or injuries promptly.

#### Privacy and Confidentiality:

• Safeguard the privacy and confidentiality of all participants, especially children, by securely managing personal information.

#### **Child Protection Training:**

• Provide regular child protection training for all staff and volunteers to equip them with the necessary knowledge and skills to identify, prevent, and respond to child safety concerns.

#### Reporting and Response:

- Establish clear procedures for reporting any suspected child abuse or safety concerns promptly.
- Respond to reports in a timely and appropriate manner, cooperating with relevant authorities as required.

#### **Review and Improvement:**

• Regularly review and update this Child-Safe Policy to ensure its effectiveness and compliance with current best practices and regulations.

By adhering to these guidelines, St George Dance Eisteddfod aims to create an environment where children feel secure, valued, and can fully enjoy their participation in our event.
