Danni Da Ros started singing and performing at the age of 10, having multiple professional performances under her belt in the corporate event and TV sector by the time she was 12. At 15, Danni was selected to train in Los Angeles with Singing Teacher to the Stars Seth Riggs (Michael Jackson, Bette Midler, Natalie Cole) and since then has been sharing her voice with the world performing in countries such as the USA, Dubai , Solomon Islands and Singapore and was the featured singer for Qatars Olympic bid in 2007 broadcast throughout the Middle East on Al Jazeera.

Danni also had her chance to shine in Australia making the top 4 on Team Delta in first season of The Voice Australia. This success gave her 4 singles in the top 100 iTunes Chart (Including a number 19 single with "Alone") and saw her signed with Universal Music Australia.

Most recently Danni was invited to Shenzhen in China to lecture students and teachers on contemporary vocal techniques and performance.

After graduating from The Australian Institute of Music with a Bachelor of Music (Honours) Danni became the Head Of Singing at Brent Street Studios. Since then, Danni opened her own Performing Arts School, Famous Performing Arts and continues to develop and nurture young vocalists and performers.
