EDUCATION GROUP SECTIONS

No curtain allowed – Blackouts only

A. Infants School Groups -

SECTIONS: Any Style

B. Primary School Groups -

SECTIONS: Jazz, Lyrical & Hip Hop

C. Junior High School Groups - years 7, 8 & 9

SECTIONS: Jazz, Lyrical, Contemporary & Hip Hop

D. Senior High School Groups - years 10,11,12

SECTIONS: Jazz, Lyrical, Contemporary & Hip Hop

E. High School Groups (years 7-12) *

***must be a mix of years from Junior and Senior High School**

SECTIONS: Jazz, Lyrical, Contemporary & Hip Hop

(High School Sections will be combined if not enough entries in each Genre or Section)

1. Schools may enter these sections more than once with different Routines. Groups must consist of 4 or more competitors no maximum.

2. PRIZES

1st Place \$ 100 plus a Trophy - students receive a ribbon

2nd Place Trophy - students receive a ribbon

3rd Place Trophy - students receive a ribbon

EISTEDDFOD ENTRY POLICY:

- a) In order to uphold child protection standards, we do not permit any camera or media devices to photograph, video or film children within our venues.
By entering as a competitor or general entry into our venues you agree to restrain from doing so. Together we can ensure our Children are safe.
- b) Whilst competitors are performing on stage please remain seated and refrain from entering and moving around the Auditorium.
- c) Respectful acknowledgement of all Competitors Performance(s).
- d) Keep all area's clean and tidy.
- e) Please acknowledge, act and respect any action or direction given by Volunteers and Committee Members.

ST GEORGE DANCE EISTEDDFOD GENERAL RULES

1. TIME LIMITS: Education Groups 5 minutes
2. OFFICIAL TIMERS:
Schools exceeding time limits will be penalised, time allowed over must be within 30 seconds. Schools will be disqualified before adjudication is given and will receive a report only.
3. BACKSTAGE
3 Teachers / Support person(s) are allowed backstage with competitors, if more assistance is required for movement of props please check with Stage Manager
4. PROMPTING:
Is allowed for INFANTS GROUPS only
5. CURTAINS:
No Curtains allowed
6. PROPS: TO BE KEPT TO A MINIMUM.
Students / Teachers are responsible for arranging their own props to be placed on and taken off stage.
Please no messy props like hay or loose paper. If using these items they must be completely covered and secured in plastic, any mess left on stage after the performance must be cleaned by Teachers or Students. Props must not be left on the premises – the Eisteddfod Committee takes no responsibility for loss or damage.
7. DRESSING ROOMS:
Teachers are responsible for cleaning up their dressing rooms / spaces, this rule must be adhered to - otherwise a \$50 cleaning fee will be charged.
FOOD AND DRINK: Must not be taken into any dressing rooms **Water is allowed**
8. COSTUMES:
Inappropriate costuming and suggestive movements in all forms of dance will not be tolerated and the adjudicator has the authority to ask that this item be stopped immediately.
9. SECTIONS:
If for any reason there are not enough entries in sections they will be combined.
10. TAP SHOES:
Must not be worn in the hall unless covers or socks are worn.
11. COMPETITORS:
Compete strictly in all sections at their own risk, no responsibility will be taken for any accident, injury or loss of property, this includes all persons present as well as competitors.
12. PROTESTS/QUERIES
All protests or queries must be lodged with Official Committee. Protests must be lodged with a fee of \$100 if upheld will be returned otherwise fee will be retained.
13. ADJUDICATORS DECISION:
Adjudicators decision is final, there is to be no communication with the Adjudicator except the Official Committee.

14. PROGRAMMES:

No changes to the programme except where it is the fault of the Committee.
Competitors must dance in order of the programme.

15. LATE ENTRIES: All late entries will dance first in their section.

16. MUSIC:

Competitors Music: accepting CD's and USB's Must be played by Officials only, Music is to be handed backstage upon section being called, otherwise you will be marked absent and be unable to compete in that section. Only one track on device and must be audio file. Device must be clearly marked with competitors Name, Section Number, Competitor Number, Tag if required We will not be accepting I pads, I phones or I pods or anything else. ONLY a CD or USB COMPETITORS MUST NOTIFY OFFICIAL IF COMMENCING ON STAGE

17. DVD'S:

An Official Videographer will be available to record your child's performances.

NO other cameras OR DEVICES are to be used for this purpose. This is a copyright rule the Eisteddfod is a licensed body with APRA. Students are to complete a DVD Order Form which can be collected from the Official Table.

18. PHOTOGRAPHER:

NO PHOTOS TO BE TAKEN IN AUDITORIUM BY ANYONE AT ANYTIME ON ANY DEVICE UNLESS AUTHORISED BY ST GEORGE DANCE EISTEDDFOD COMMITTEE.

19. APPOINTED OFFICIALS

Appointed officials have full authority during Eisteddfod.

20. SAFETY:

Every care will be taken for the Competitors safety, but the Committee will not be responsible for any injuries sustained by any Competitor during the Eisteddfod.

21. RULES:

Any rule may be amended at the discretion of the Committee.

22. NO SMOKING:

No one is permitted to smoke in any part of the venue or grounds.

23. MOBILES and any ELECTRONIC DEVICES:

Are to be switched off in all venues. Mobiles can be left on if switched to silent.
These devices cannot be used for photography and/or Videoing

No dates or times will be given out over the telephone regarding your children's entries, the programme will be available on the Website for you to download In approximately 3 weeks before the Eisteddfod commences.
